CIRCUMSTANCES OF ARREST

On 02-15-2008, at approximately 1343 hours, Palo Verde High School let out for the day. Fifteen year old, Christopher Privett was walking home with three friends, [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The friends were walking on the north sidewalk of Alta, east of Pavilion Center when numerous shots were fired at them from a silver, four door, Pontiac Grand Am which was traveling east on Alta from Pavilion Center. Privett was shot once in the chest and fell to the ground. [REDACTED] was struck by a bullet, which penetrated the backpack he was wearing on his back. [REDACTED] was uninjured. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were traveling east on Alta Drive when they heard the gunshots and saw Privett lying on the ground. The Whites turned around and went to the aid of Privett and performed CPR until medical personnel arrived. Privett was transported by medical personnel to the Summerlin Hospital where he was pronounced dead at 1442 hours by Dr. Donahoe.

When Detectives responded to the scene, several witnesses including the children who were walking with the victim were interviewed. [REDACTED] had just picked up her niece [REDACTED] from Palo Verde High School, and was stopped at the traffic light west of Pavilion Center on Alta when she saw a champagne colored 4-door Pontiac stopped at the light next to her. [REDACTED] said the driver of the Pontiac was honking his horn at a black female standing on the northwest corner of Alta and Pavilion Center and calling her over to the car. [REDACTED] said she thought two black females got into the back seat of the Pontiac before the Pontiac sped off at a high rate of speed east on Alta Drive from Pavilion Center. [REDACTED] said she followed the Pontiac east on Alta Drive and watched as an unknown person stuck their arm out of a window on the left side of the car and fired four shots from a handgun at the victims. [REDACTED] said after the shots were fired the Pontiac continued eastbound on Alta at a high rate of speed. Other witnesses also described seeing the silver colored Pontiac 4-door, and indicated it was occupied by at least two Black Males and one Black Female. The witnesses also indicated the gunshots came from the left, or driver's side of the car. [REDACTED] who was walking with the victim, told Detectives he saw the silver Pontiac parked on Pavilion Center Drive on the east side of Palo Verde High School moments before the shooting occurred.

When Detectives and Crime Scene Analysts arrived at the scene, they located four expended .22 caliber cartridge casings lying in the eastbound lanes of Alta Drive near the vicinity where the witnesses saw an occupant of the silver Pontiac fire at the victims.

On 02-15-08, at approximately 2000 hours, LVMPD received a call from [REDACTED] who said her daughter [REDACTED], and her daughter's friend [REDACTED] were in the silver Pontiac that was involved in the shooting at Palo Verde High School earlier in the afternoon. Detective Hardy and I responded to [REDACTED]'s residence and interviewed her and [REDACTED]. During the interview, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said they attend Palo Verde High School, and were at school on 02-15-08. They said when they got out of school at approximately 1330 hours, they saw a friend of theirs by the name of Gerald (later identified as Gerald Davison) on the east side of the school by the bus parking area. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] asked Davison if his friend Ezekiel (later identified as Ezekiel Williams) would give them a ride, and Davison said he didn't think so. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said while they were talking to Davison, Williams pulled up in a silver colored, 4-door, Pontiac Grand Am with tinted windows and stopped on Pavilion Center Drive on the east side of Palo Verde High School. [REDACTED] said a black female by the name of [REDACTED] (later identified as [REDACTED]) was sitting in the right front passenger seat, and Davison got into the backseat behind the driver and blocked her and [REDACTED] from getting in the car. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said Williams drove to Alta and Pavilion Center, turned west on Alta, made a U-turn and stopped at the traffic light on Alta and Pavilion Center Drive. [REDACTED] said she and [REDACTED] were standing at the NW corner of Alta and Pavilion Center when Williams began honking at her and telling them to get in the car. [REDACTED] said she got into the backseat and sat in the center next to Davison, and [REDACTED] got into the backseat and sat next to the right rear passengers' door. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said when the light turned green, Williams accelerated through the intersection eastbound on Alta. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said as they drove through the intersection Davison had both of his hands between his legs near the floorboard and "racked" a pistol. Walker said as the car continued east on Alta, Davison fired several shots out of the left rear passenger window at the victims. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said after the shooting, [REDACTED] told them the shooting was in retaliation for an altercation which had occurred on the northwest corner of Alta and Pavilion Center between the victims and her in which the victim's "threw" gang signs at her. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said after the shooting Williams drove them to [REDACTED] house and dropped them off. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said the shooter whom they only knew as Gerald was in 10th grade and attended Palo Verde High School.

Based on information provided by [REDACTED], Detectives identified [REDACTED], and through the phone number provided by [REDACTED] Detectives identified the driver of the silver Pontiac as Ezekiel Williams III who lives at [REDACTED] Ironside Drive in Las Vegas. When Detectives arrived at Williams residence, they saw Williams arriving in the silver Pontiac Grand Am, Nevada license 871UCC.

I interviewed Williams, and he told me he was with [REDACTED] and another black male by the name of Gerald (Davison), and that the three went to Palo Verde High School on 02-15-08 at approximately 1320 hours. Williams said while at the school he picked up two other black females by the name of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Williams said he picked up Davison on Pavilion Center Drive on the east side of the school, and picked up [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at the intersection of Alta and Pavilion Center. Williams said just prior to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] getting in his car, Davison told him he found a .22 caliber pistol in the back seat, and handed the gun to Williams. Williams said he looked at the gun, then handed it back to Davison and told him to put it away. Williams said after [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] got into the car he drove east on Alta Drive from Pavilion Center. Williams said as he was driving east, Davison who was seated in the left rear passenger seat fired several shots at the victims. Williams said there was an altercation between Davison and three black males and a Hispanic male on the east side of Palo Verde High School moments before to the shooting.

After Davison fired at the victim's, Williams drove out of the area and to a parking lot where he pulled over and asked Davison to give him the gun. Williams said after Davison gave him the gun he hid it behind the center console in the car below the radio. Williams said he then dropped [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] off at [REDACTED] house, then dropped Davison off at the intersection of Smoke Ranch and Decatur Blvd. Williams also told me that after he returned home he took the floor mats out of his car and put them in the trunk, then wiped down the interior of the left rear passenger with bleach to destroy the gunpowder residue. Williams also said he searched the car for ammunition and found an expended .22 caliber cartridge casing in the backseat of his car which he initially said he threw in the trash, then said he threw in the rocks. Williams also told me he dropped off Davison at Centennial and Lossee Road, then changed it to Decatur and Smoke Ranch.

Based on information from [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] that Gerald (Davison) attended Palo Verde High, CCSD Police were able to locate Davison in the schools attendance records, and identified him as Gerald Davison. [REDACTED] Detective O'Kelley constructed a photo lineup using a CCJH booking photo of Davison taken on 02-10-08, and I showed the lineup to Williams who immediately identified Davison as the person who shot at the victim's.

On 02-16-08, at approximately 0325 hours, Detectives located Davison at [REDACTED] Harmony Avenue and took him into custody. Davison was transported to the Homicide Office where Detective Hardy and I interviewed him. After Davison was advised of his Miranda Rights via an LVMPD Advisement of Persons Arrested Card he confessed to shooting at the victims. Davison told us his intention was to scare the victims after the altercation in front of the school. Davison also told us that the pistol he used to shoot at the victims with was a .22 caliber Luger. Davison told Detectives that Williams handed him the gun moments before the shooting, and said "are you gonna do it, you gonna get at them" meaning the victims. Davison was placed under arrest for Murder with a Deadly Weapon, and three counts of Attempted Murder, and Firing from an occupied vehicle. Davison was booked into the Clark County Juvenile Detention Center.

On 02-19-08, I received information that a person by the name of [REDACTED] may have disposed of the gun after the shooting. Detective Hardy and I identified [REDACTED] as [REDACTED]. We interviewed [REDACTED] and he told us he went to Williams house on 02-15-08 at approximately 1600 hours to pick up his gun which he described as a black, Ruger .22 caliber, semiautomatic pistol. [REDACTED] said Zeke (Williams) gave him the gun and later told him to clean the gun. [REDACTED] also said Williams told him that he "got at some niggas, and left." [REDACTED] said after picking the gun up from Williams he took the gun to a friend of his house. [REDACTED] took Detectives to [REDACTED] N. Rainbow Blvd., Apt [REDACTED] where Detectives recovered the Ruger .22 caliber pistol.

On 02-19-08, Detective Hardy and I re-interviewed Williams. After advising Williams of his Miranda Rights, Williams admitted to cleaning his car out in order to dispose of evidence, and admitted to lying about the location of the pistol used in the murder. Williams also said he knowingly hid from Detectives the fact that the suspect in the murder of Christopher Privett may be hiding at [REDACTED] house. Williams also told us that he was aware that Davison had a bad temper.

Based on the fact that Williams handed the pistol used in the murder to Davison moments before the shooting, and that Williams hid from Detectives the fact that he disposed of the pistol used in the murder and knew the name of the person he gave the pistol to, and that Williams attempted to obliterate and remove evidence from the vehicle used in the murder, and that he hid the location of the suspect from Detectives, he was placed under arrest for Accessory After the fact to Murder with

a Deadly Weapon and three counts of Accessory After the fact to Attempted Murder with a Deadly Weapon.
